

## **Warrior Run Announces 2018 Hall of Fame Class**

The Warrior Run School District and the district's Hall of Fame Committee are proud to announce the 2018 Hall of Fame Class. This year's class includes Rebecca Gage Bailey (1993), Christopher Hill (1990), and Dr. Alvin Weaver (1993). This year's formal Hall of Fame Induction Banquet will be held at the Watson Inn on September 22, 2018 at 5:30 pm.

### **Rebecca Gage Bailey (1993)**

Rebecca Gage Bailey was a 1993 graduate of Warrior Run High School. After graduating from Warrior Run, Rebecca attended Bloomsburg University, graduating in 1996 with a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration. From Bloomsburg University, Rebecca attended the University of Baltimore School of Law in Maryland. She gained entry in the Maryland Bar and completed a clerkship in Montgomery County, MD. She also became a member of the Washington, D.C. Bar. In 2003, she accepted a position in the mass tort litigation department of the law firm of Steptoe and Johnson.

After two years in private practice, Ms. Bailey accepted a position in government service, working at the United States Department of Veterans Affairs in the Baltimore/Washington D.C. Regional Counsel Office. Here, she served for nearly nine years. Her focus while at the Department of Veterans Affairs was on employment law. During her tenure, she was admitted to the Bar of the United States Supreme Court. Starting in 2013 through her untimely death, Rebecca worked at the National Security Agency in the Office of the General Counsel. While there, she was promoted to associate general counsel. Rebecca was a lifelong blood donor and a passionate contributor to animal causes, particularly the SPCA of Anne Arundel County, MD.

### **Christopher Hill (1990)**

Chris Hill was a 1990 graduate of Warrior Run High School. While a student, Chris lettered in both Track and Field and Football for the Defenders, rushing for nearly 1,000 yards before attending Pennsylvania College of Technology and Waynesburg College where he was also a member of the football team.

Mr. Hill joined the United States Army in 1993 becoming an Army Ranger. During his military enlistment, Chris spent time serving, among other places, in Somalia. After his military service, Chris gained employment with the Florida State Department of Corrections for nearly a decade fulfilling roles as a training officer, transportation instructor and firearms instructor. In 2006, Chris became a Deputy United States Marshall, stationed first in Washington, D.C. and eventually transferring to Harrisburg, PA in 2009. In 2012, Mr. Hill spent a year in Afghanistan as a member of a special team establishing a judicial system. He was awarded the U.S. Marshall Service Distinguished Group Award. In 2013, Chris began serving as a firearms instructor, tactical trainer, repelling instructor and munitions expert as a member of the U.S. Marshall elite Special Operations Group. While working in Harrisburg, Chris organized the "Bring Your Child to Work Day" in all of the federal buildings in the region. Sadly, Chris Hill lost his life in the line of duty on January 18th, 2018.

**Dr. Alvin Weaver (1993)**

Dr. Alvin Weaver is a 1993 graduate of Warrior Run High School. While a student at Warrior Run, Alvin was a member of the Concert Choir for four years, performed in school musicals every year, participated in District Chorus, was a member of the Warrior Run Band, French Club, and he worked on the *Eagle's Perch*. After graduating from Warrior Run, Dr. Weaver attended Pennsylvania College of Technology where he earned an Associate's Degree and Bachelor's Degree in Human Services, graduating in 2002. He went on to earn a Master of Science from Capella University, a Doctor of Science in Human Services from Oneida University and a Doctor of Education from Capella University. He began a career in Human Services with Diversified Treatment Alternatives in Lewisburg and has worked in the mental health field performing a vast variety of roles from childcare worker, caseworker, and administrative roles within the field at Diversified Treatment Alternatives in Lewisburg and Danville, Behavioral Specialists, Incorporated in Lewisburg and Williamsport. Dr. Weaver is a Board Certified Practitioner in Human Services and has exemplified a willingness to serve diverse needs in the field.

In addition to his professional accomplishments, Dr. Weaver has served on the Milton Area School District Board of Directors since 2010, as a member and vice president and president. He and his wife have also been foster parents for two teenage boys. He is an active member of the First Baptist Church of Milton's Choir and Service Ministry Team, and he has done mission work in Kenya where he worked with several all-girls schools on leadership and women in regard to the future of Kenya. Alvin also sat on the board for "Big Brothers, Big Sisters", volunteered for youth athletic booster programs and participated in the Milton Harvest Festival Pop's Concert.
